

GOOD FRIDAY FAMILY WORSHIP GUIDE

SCRIPTURE

As a family, read the following Scripture out loud. (take turns if children are of reading age; if children are younger, try reading from the New Living Translation)

Mark 15:1-47

PONDER

Why do you think Jesus remained silent when he was being questioned by Pilate? (Have someone read Isaiah 53:7)
How did the curtain of the temple tear? Why is that important? How did the centurion come to realize Jesus was the Son of God?
Just like the centurion, when we stand and face Jesus' sacrifice and observe the way He suffered for us, it leads us to a point of decision - who do we believe that Jesus is, and how does that impact the rest of our lives?

PRAYER

Pray as you feel led and encourage other family members to pray out loud as well. Here is a brief example for direction:

Thank you Jesus for giving up your life for me on the cross. You endured more than I can possibly imagine for the sake of rescuing me. It is only by your sacrifice that I am forgiven and have peace with God. May I never grow cold or indifferent to the love that you've shown me.
